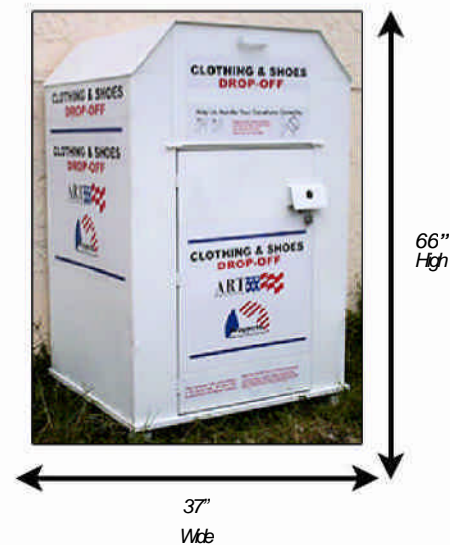




**AmericasRelief Team is seeking support from businesses and organizations who can provide space to host our clothing bins!**

In December 2008, AmericasRelief launched its clothing and shoe drive. Just as most other charitable organizations, AmericasRelief Team sells most of the donated reusable and recyclable used clothing to raise funds for the programs of the organization.

AmericasRelief Team uses clothing collection bins as a means of generating funds for their programs in Latin America and the Caribbean. The income AmericasRelief Team receives from used clothing collection bins will go to underwrite such things as shipping, transportation, and warehousing of relief aid to make sure it gets to those in need as fast as possible.



Here are some questions you may have about hosting:

**Q: How much does it cost to host a bin?**

*Nothing! Hosting is on a VOLUNTEER basis.*

**Q: How often do you empty the bins?**

*We empty the bins every week or many times as needed.*

**Q: If, for some reason, I decide I do not want the bin anymore, will you remove it?**

**Q: Are the collection bins safe:**

*Yes, no one can climb inside. They are fully insured, fireproof, and cannot be moved. Our specially designed deposit chute allows donors to drop items in but restricts them from pulling items out.*
